

Hummingbird workshop, 18 – 24 January 2019.

Summary

This workshop will be held in Nono, the land of my ancestors.

A place at the foot of the Pichincha volcano in the highland Andes Mountains. The place is located an hour and a half from the city of Quito.

You will visit places of hummingbird observation in Yanacocha and we will spend the rest of the time in Nono neighborhood where you can make observations of different species of hummingbirds. Approximately 35 species in the area.

The cost of the workshop includes the collection of people at the airport and the return to it, the various transports to the areas mentioned. Three meals and snacks.

Goals

The workshop in its greater objective: the emotional, spiritual and physical contact with the hummingbirds and the respective ceremonies for the invocations and sightings.

The different methods of healing with hummingbirds and their healing qualities for human beings, in three different levels.

The methodology of the workshop includes invitation and talk with experts in ornithology.

Workshop management

There will be daily sessions, group work, and discussions about the experiences lived day by day.

Books and documents to analyze what is observed in the field

This workshop always offers the learning and healing practices for the participants.

This activity is completely unique, intellectual and ancestral property of Rocío Alarcón Gallegos. This technique was developed by her ancestors and by my person during the process of interaction with the natural landscape and energy communication with the different hummingbirds in the mentioned areas.

It will be possible to visit the places where my grandparents and great-grandparents planted the floripondios considered by experts in botany as the oldest in the area and their tree-like appearance!!!! They were planted to protect certain species of hummingbirds.

The cost of the workshop includes:

- The collection of people at the airport and the return to it, the various transports to the areas mentioned.
- Three meals and snacks.
- Lodgings.
